

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Summer 2024, Duluth (GA)

Bridging the Gap is a 40-hour professional development program that prepares bilingual individuals to work as medical interpreters. It is used to train novice and experienced medical interpreters, and it is accepted by both accredited national certifying bodies, the Certification Commission for Healthcare Interpreters (CCHI) and the National Board of Certification for Medical Interpreters (NBCMI). Additionally, Horizon Language Services provides language coaching effectively achieving 46 hours of training. No interpreting experience is required in order to take the class.

This course offering by Horizon Language Services covers:

- **Basic interpreting skills.** Roles, ethics, conduit and clarifier interpreting, managing the flow of the session.
- Codes of ethics. Codes of ethics and decision-making for interpreters in health care.
- **Integrated medical terminology, anatomy, and physiology.** Introduction to common terms, procedures, and specialties relating to human physiology and health.
- **Information on health care systems.** Introduction to the health care systems and types of healthcare providers.
- **Culture in interpreting.** Self-awareness, basic characteristics of specific cultures, traditional health care in specific communities, culture brokering.
- **Communication skills for advocacy.** Listening skills, communication styles, how doctors think, appropriate advocacy.
- **Professional development.** Effective communication, professional conduct, self-care, resources for professional growth.
- Language coaching. Interactive, guided interpreting exercises.

About the Class

Total tuition: \$850 (Early bird pricing if registration completed by April 12: \$750)

Includes non-refundable \$100 registration fee, course textbooks, bilingual medical glossary if available in your target language (if not available participants will receive an English-English glossary), the *Guide* to *Common Medications*, and

a signed Certificate of Successful Completion, if applicable.

Admission Requirements

Minimum age and education

Participants must be 18 or older and have a high school degree or the equivalent. Proof of high school graduation or GED, etc. is required.

Proof of language proficiency

Participants must be bilingual in English and at least one other language, and proof of proficiency in <u>both</u> languages is required to enroll in the class. Proof of proficiency can be **copies of any one of the following documents**:

- High school diploma or equivalent, or university/college degree from a school using the assessed language(s).
- 5 or more years of verified professional experience working in the language(s) being assessed.
- State or federal court interpreter certification.
- Oral language exam results with scores equivalent to ACTFL Advanced Mid-level or ILR Level 2.

If an applicant does not have any prior proof of language proficiency, the registration process will include an additional \$76 fee in order to complete a speaking and listening assessment. Registration and scheduling is facilitated by HLS, and will be administered by ALTA Language Services over video communication, on a weekday at a time that is convenient for the applicant. Once scheduled, the applicant will receive instructions to complete the assessment, which is approximately 20–25 minutes long. The maximum possible score is 12; a 9 or higher is required for admission.

application form and you will receive an invoice with additional payment information.

The need for a language assessment will be determined upon receipt of the deposit and all other required documentation. The language assessment will incur a separate \$76 fee and it will be scheduled upon receipt of fee payment.

- 3. Once we have received proof of language proficiency or proficiency assessment results, you will receive notification to the email address provided about the status of your application. You will also receive an email if you did not pass the language proficiency assessment.
- 4. Confirm your attendance and pay the tuition balance of \$750 (\$650 if following the early bird schedule).
 - Payment options and instructions will be included in the invoice for the remaining tuition.



Deadlines

In order to qualify for early bird pricing all application materials and payments must be received according to the early bird schedule.

April 19, 2024:

Remaining tuition fees

Refund Policy

HLS reserves the right to cancel or postpone a class that does not meet minimum enrollment. Unless a class is canceled by HLS, the \$100 registration fee is non-refundable. However, if a course applicant becomes unable to attend a course they had registered for, the registration fee can be held for one calendar year from the start date of the original course registered for.

For the remaining tuition, the refund policy is as follows:

Up to 1 week before class starts	100%
1-6 days before class starts	75%
After class starts	25%

Note: Instead of a refund, applicants can choose to leave their balance paid to HLS to use for another class within 1 calendar year from the start date of the class originally applied for.

HLS reserves the right to remove any participant who interferes with or causes disruption in the learning environment. Refunds will not be issued to participants who are removed.



Certificates of Successful Completion

A Pre-Test and a Final Test will be given to measure participants' improvement before and after the training. Certificates of successful completion will be awarded to participants who score 70% or better on the Final Test. Participants will be notified via email about their test results within one month of completing the course. Certificates will be mailed within two months after the training.

Participants who do not pass the Final Test are permitted one retake within a 3-month period. If a participant does not pass the Final Test after the permitted re-take, CCHCP will not issue a certificate of successful completion.

Students must attend all hours of the training and pass the Final Test to earn a certificate of successful completion. This certificate can be used as proof of training for national certification and other bodies that require proof of training.

Receiving a BTG certificate of completion is proof that a participant is a trained medical interpreter. In order to become a nationally certified medical interpreter, participants who successfully complete the course should take and pass national certification exams through the National Board of Certification for Medical Interpreters (www.certifiedmedicalinterpreters.org) or the Certification Commission for Healthcare Interpreters (www.cchicertification.org). Some states may have their own state certification exams to be a state-certified medical interpreter.

Language Coaching

In addition to the 40-hour BTG curriculum, the training by HLS includes time reserved for interactive practice opportunities in-class. Also, whenever possible, HLS will bring experienced language coaches for each attendee's specific language. Submitting the application sooner than later increases the odds that a coach will be available and applicants will be notified before completing registration.
